

CITY OF ST. CATHARINES

BY-LAW NO. 2023-137

A By-law to impose certain rates and fees charged by The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines with respect to certain administrative matters.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines has, pursuant to various authorities, the right to impose fees with respect to certain administrative matters from time to time;

AND WHEREAS since it is the intention of this Council to review and pass a multi-year by-law to establish fees for the years 2024-2026, that by giving the required public notice and holding a public meeting, The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines has complied with the statutory notices required, and notice of the said by-law was posted to the City of St. Catharines website on June 2, 2023 and the public meeting was held on June 26, 2023;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. CATHARINES enacts as follows:

1. That the goods and services described in Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" attached hereto shall be provided by The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines upon the payment of the fee for such goods or services as described in Schedule "A" and Schedule "B".
2. This By-law shall be deemed to supercede and replace By-law No. 2022-128 and amendments thereto.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2024.

4. The provisions contained in Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" attached hereto which require approval of any authority other than the Council of The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines shall come into force and effect upon receipt of such approval.

5. That where this By-law establishes a fee for the provision of goods or services that is established by another by-law of The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines existing as of the effective date of this By-law, the fee established by this By-law shall supersede and be the applicable fee or rate for the provision of goods or services established by that other by-law.


6. That where Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) and/or Retail Sales Tax (RST) are applicable to a fee established by this By-law, the amount of the applicable tax be included in the amount shown under the column titled "Fee Paid by Customer before Surcharges" applicable to that fee in Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" attached hereto.

7. That where a surcharge is applicable to a fee established by this By-law, the amount of the surcharge is not included in the amounts shown under the column titled "Fee Paid by Customer before Surcharges" in the tables contained in Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" attached hereto.
